UMGMA Membership Definitions

1. **Individual Member:** A Utah resident who directly works in any capacity of medical practice management, regardless of practice size. This includes such positions as: Medical Practice Administrator, Practice Manager, Clinic Manager, Center Manager, Office Manager, Executive Director, CEO, Operations Director, Assistant Manager, Front Line Supervisor, etc. An Individual Member possesses voting rights and is eligible to serve as an Association Officer.
2. **Associate Member:** An associate member is an individual who has a Utah presence by working in an ancillary or supporting capacity to Utah-based medical practice operations. This includes billing, contracting, marketing, provider relations, consulting, insurance, etc. An associate member may serve as directed by the Executive Committee, but may not vote or be eligible to serve as an Association Officer. ***Associate members must use separate Associate Membership Application.**
3. **Student Member:** A full-time student currently enrolled in 12 or more units at any college or university in the State of Utah. While a Student Member may participate on committee assignments, he or she shall not be a voting member or eligible to serve as an Association Officer.
